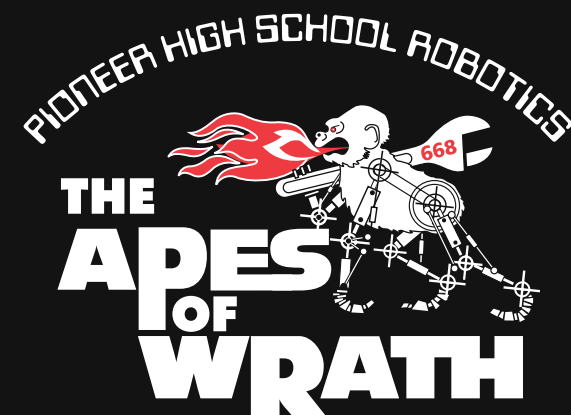
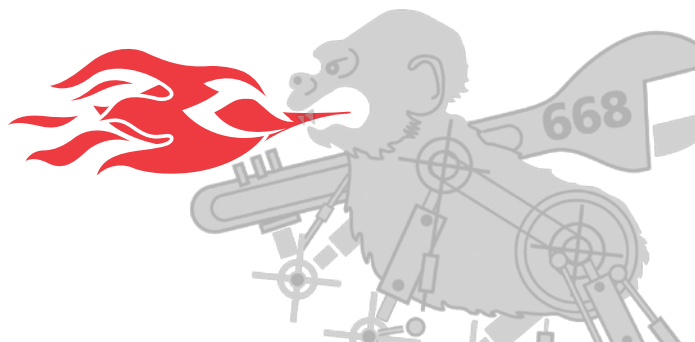

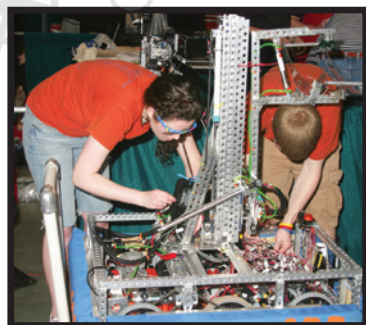
Help Inspire Young People to Pursue Math, Science and Technology

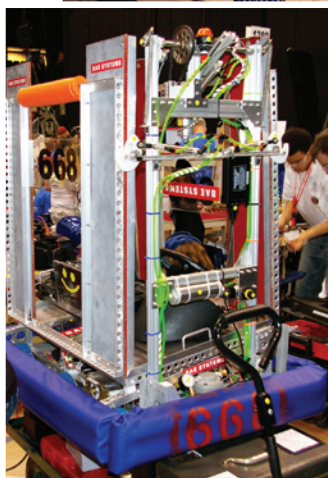
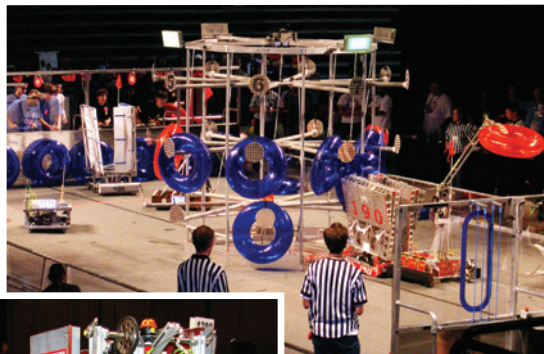
Each year, the students work with engineers to design and build a robot that they compete with in the FIRST robotics competitions. In addition, The Apes of Wrath robotics team is committed to developing and supporting new FIRST robotics teams. This program provides real-life experiences and problem-solving opportunities that develop the math, science and technology skills needed in young people in order to ensure the future vitality of our community.



The Apes of Wrath is operated as an after-school program and is entirely self-funded by student fund-raising and community and corporate sponsorship.
